- ENTRANT MUST BE A RESIDENT OR FULL-TIME HIGH SCHOOL/COLLEGE STUDENT IN THESE NORTHEAST GEORGIA COUNTIES: TOWNS, UNION, RABUN, WHITE, HABERSHAM, STEPHENS, LUMPKIN, FANNIN OR NORTH CAROLINA COUNTIES: CLAY, CHEROKEE.
- ENTRANT MUST BE SINGLE, NEVER HAVE BEEN MARRIED OR HAD A MARRIAGE ANNULLED, NOR HAVE CHILDREN AND BE A BIOLOGICALLY BORN FEMALE.

Interviews will be held at Anderson Music Hall. Park in the same location as you did for orientation. Interviews will be a 5-7 minute session with all 3 Judges. Contestants should wear a conservative dress or pants for interview. **Remember** this is an INTERVIEW so dress accordingly.

Bring something comfortable to change into for dress rehearsal. Dress rehearsal will follow interviews. This is your time to practice everything on stage. Bring shoes you will be wearing with your evening gown. CD or USB for optional talent contestants should be brought to dress rehearsal so they can be forwarded to the GMF sound technician.
